## ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT COURSES

Approved by the Australian Resuscitation Council

The advanced life support (ALS) course teaches the theory and practical skills to effectively treat cardiorespiratory arrest, peri-arrest situations and special circumstances and to prepare members of a team to treat the patient until transfer to a critical care area is possible.

ALS level 1 is suitable for medical staff as part of a team providing management to the patient in the immediate period of crisis. It includes the recognition, assessment and immediate management of the deteriorating patient and skills for dealing with a cardiac arrest or other medical emergencies in a clinical setting. Included in the course is:

- + Recognition, assessment and management of the critically ill patient using a structured ABCDE approach.
- + Airway management skills.
- + Basic Life Support.
- + Defibrillation skills (Manual and/or AED modes).
- + Cardiac arrest management using the ARC ALS Algorithm.
- + Work as an effective team member in a cardiac arrest.

ALS level 2 is suitable for all medical staff who wish to improve their technical understanding of the procedures used in managing cardiac arrest and the dynamics of a critical care team. In addition to the elements covered in the ALS 1 course, teaches the knowledge and skills required to:

- + Treat cardiac and/or respiratory arrest, including manual defibrillation.
- + Cardiac arrest management using the ARC ALS Algorithm.
- + Preparing and planning for post resuscitation care.
- + Care for the deteriorating patient or patient in cardiac arrest and/or respiratory arrest in special circumstances such as asthma, anaphylaxis, and pregnancy.
- + Lead a team, work as a team member, and use structured communication skills including giving an effective handover.
