Identifying and Responding to Domestic and Family Violence

 1 Hour study time | Course Fee: \$22 |  RACGP Accredited Category 2 – 2 Points

This short e-learning course provides practical ways that health practitioners can increase their skills in identifying and responding to domestic and family violence. We outline how and when to ask about this sensitive issue and what to do when a patient discloses to enable a best practice response and referral.

This course is suitable for any GP, student or health care practitioner.

Clinical Supervision Online

 10 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$350 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

The Clinical Supervision Online course aims to provide the background, understanding and skills for clinicians to create a learning environment within which their learners thrive. Drawing upon the Melbourne Medical School's popular Excellence in Clinical Teaching (EXCITE) award courses in clinical education, the focus is on what's most effective in the healthcare workplace.

Clinical Supervision Online is designed for all clinicians who teach and/or supervise learners at any level.

Diabetes Academy: What's New in Diabetes

 20 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$550 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

This e-learning course provides an evidence-based update for clinicians on the novel medications and emerging technologies available to improve outcomes in people with diabetes. Clinical case studies using video vignettes and multiple-choice questions are designed to optimise comprehension and learning.

The course is suitable for GPs, physician trainees, endocrinologists, endocrinology trainees, practice nurses, diabetes nurse educators, general physicians, pharmacists, dietitians, allied health professionals and students.

Osteosarcopenia: Preventing Falls and Fractures in Older Persons

 15 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$550 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

Osteosarcopenia is a newly recognised disease and now has its own ICD code, this means that there will be an increase in availability in diagnostic tools to help your older patients gain more confidence and freedom. Osteosarcopenia, a combination of osteoporosis and sarcopenia, is where individuals experience a synchronic loss of BMD and muscle mass, strength, and function which represents a huge threat to a loss of independence. Although medical practitioners may be aware of the importance of fall prevention in the elderly, the newness of sarcopenia and osteosarcopenia means these conditions are rarely diagnosed and risks identified for falls and fractures.

The course is specifically designed for medical practitioners. It provides a comprehensive education on osteoporosis, sarcopenia and the newer condition 'osteosarcopenia' in older persons.

Management of Obesity

 12 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$550 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

In recent years, advances have been made in our understanding of the biology of obesity, which has led to the development of new treatment approaches. Management of Obesity is an online course developed by physicians specialising in obesity research and clinical practice. The course is designed to provide an evidence-based approach for managing patients who are seeking treatment for obesity.

The course is suitable for GPs, physicians, doctors in training, dietitians, allied health professionals and students.

Urinary Incontinence Management in Women

 10 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$330 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

This course is designed to give health care professionals – particularly primary care physicians – a fresh look at the available approaches to resolving urinary incontinence and, importantly, how various therapies can be used in conjunction with one another to resolve this debilitating problem.

This course is suitable for all primary care physicians, including general practitioners, continence clinicians, physiotherapists and continence nurse advisors.

Migraine Management for Practitioners

 8 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$550 |  RACGP Accredited Category 1 – 40 Points

Migraine Management for Practitioners provides healthcare professionals with the latest clinical advances to improve patient lives. The course includes a comprehensive and practical diagnosis approach, management plans for acute headache attacks and preventative strategies to manage migraines.

Primary health care physicians who require an understanding of headache management, including GPs, physician trainees, practice nurses, general physicians and medical students.

Immunisation (Nurse Immuniser)

 160 Hours study time | Course Fee: \$835 |  APNA Endorsed

Immunisation (Nurse Immuniser) is a recognised program of study which aligns with the “National Immunisation Education Framework for Health Professionals”. This eLearning course provides an overview of public health and immunisation from a local and global context. The vaccines used on the national immunisation program, the recommendations for their use and revision of the immune system are studied to prepare nurses to administer vaccines autonomously.

This course is suitable for Currently registered with AHPRA as a Registered Nurse in (Division 1) with General Registration.

Haemodynamic Echocardiography Assessment in Real Time: iHeartScan & iHeartScan Advanced Workshops

OVERVIEW

The iHeartScan workshops are aimed at extending your experience and training in transthoracic echocardiography.

Participants will begin by completing the eLearning component prior to the workshop, which consists of a series of tutorials and case studies focusing on transthoracic echocardiography. Their knowledge is then reinforced with a hands-on workshop and demonstration, where under the guidance of an experienced ultrasound trainer, participants will have the opportunity to practise transthoracic ultrasound on live models.

The maximum intake per Melbourne iHeartScan workshops is 20 participants.
